English Language Arts

This week we continued on with our reading checks, spelling routine, and paragraphs. For reading comprehension we focused on reviewing the skill of distinguishing between fact and opinion through being detectives. In writing, our paragraph this week was focused on writing opinion pieces with an emphasis on persuasion. For Reading students picked out a book of their own to show comprehension. Once they finish reading they will be creating a project of choice in the classroom.

Next week we will be continuing on with our reading checks, spelling routine, and paragraphs. We will be reviewing different non-fiction text features through creating a poster/collage in the classroom. This will be our final week of spelling.

Religion

This week we are learning about fractions being part of a set, locating fractions on a number line, and equivalent fractions, as well as comparing fractions to a whole.
