School Announcements

- Field Day for JK-7th grade is Friday, May 23. It is an 11:30AM dismissal day for students—JK Extended Day and STEAM Aftercare will both be in session.
 Please read the following information carefully and ensure that your children come to school fully prepared.

All essential items needed this day (with a few rules):

- Bathing suits are not required; if worn, they must be covered by shorts and a t-shirt at all times. Swim trunks are fine but t-shirts are to remain on.
- Appropriate closed-toed shoes; sneakers are preferred (NO Crocs, flip flops, or sandals)
- Sunscreen, sunscreen! Sunscreen MUST be applied at home, as we cannot apply it to students at school
- Comfortable loose fitting athletic attire that meets dress code requirements
- A FULL change of clothes (including underwear and socks) should be brought to school
- Hats are acceptable on this day as they provide sun blockage
- No sunglasses (unless prescription)
- LABELED Water Bottle (it is very important that we stay hydrated on this day)
- Towel

In the event that it rains on May 23, Field Day will be canceled and we will have a normal school day (the 11:30 am dismissal will remain); students will need to wear their

Social Studies

We focused on science this week.

Math

We are reviewing addition, subtraction and three dimensional shapes. The students are continuing to practice the name and value of a penny, nickel, dime, quarter and half dollar. We also continued to practice counting to 100! Some of them already know how to count to 100. At this time, the students are expected to count to 100. The students have also been counting to 100 by 2s, 5s and 10s. We have calendar time during math every day.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

The students are continuing to practice reading to self and work on writing. Please have your child read the books and reading comprehension packets sent home every Friday to you three times to practice sight words and fluency. **Our sight words this week were: been, off, cold, tell, work. Our sight words for next week are: first, does, write, always, made.**

Theology

We had a retreat which included singing, songs, a Theology scavenger hunt, chapters of the book What Would Jesus Do? and a cross project and prayers. We will be participating in the rosary as a whole school every Thursday for the month of May.

Science

We spoke about the different types of habitats animals live in every day throughout the year. We also made a pop up book of the animals that were their favorite animals were at the safari park.
