Math

Ms. Shank's class has been reviewing many of the concepts we have learned so far. I am also completing some small assessments to measure whether the students can demonstrate their understanding. Ms. Wawner's class continued to practice addition and introduced subtraction through the part/part/whole method. Students will continue to practice addition and subtraction next week.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Ms. Wawner's class focused on the letter X this week. Students had fun going on an X scavenger hunt, playing tic-tac-toe, and creating x-ray hands. We have now spent special time on each letter of the alphabet and will continue to review letter identification and phonics for the rest of the year. Next week students will start learning word families. They will start with -AT and focus on a new one each week until the end of the school year. We will also continue to practice and add to our sight words list.

Ms. Shank's class is reading books with the sight words they have learned so far. We continue to look at short vowel A word families. I will be introducing the short vowel E word families, (-et, -eb, -en). If time we will move on to the other vowel families. The year has gone by so fast. We will begin a unit on Dr. Suess and nursery rhymes next week.

Religion

Ms. Shank's continues to study the Fruits of the Spirit. The students are creating a booklet and drawing pictures to go with each "fruit". So far we have talked about love, joy, and peace.

Science

Ms. Wawner's class started a Social Students unit on Community Helpers. We talked about what a community is and different types of communities (city, town, suburb, countryside). We then identified different community helpers and talked about their jobs. This week, we focused on those who keep us safe and those who work at schools. We learned about a firefighters day on the job and had the chance to role play. We will continue with our community helper unit next week.

Ms. Shank's and Ms. Wawner's caterpillars are now butterflies. The students are fascinated. Ms. Shank's class started our community helpers unit. That unt will continue.
