## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

#### Reading

We continued poetry by learning about the elements of poetry including rhythm and rhyme. We read and listened to a lot of different types of poems including haiku, cinquain and freestyle poems.

#### <u>Grammar</u>

We continued to learn about elements of poetry: alliteration and onomatopoeia.

#### Writing

We continued to write about and explore different types of poetry. We also wrote in our daily writing journals and practiced our handwriting. Next week we will introduce how to write a letter.

## Theology

This week we had our First Communion Retreat, where we learned about the parts of mass, the Eucharist and how to prepare for Jesus.

## Social Studies

We focused on science this week.

## Science

We continued our animal research project. The students have been learning all about different animal habitats and life cycles.
