#### Math Practice at Home

Tell the time on a clock in your house to the hour or half hour. Identify coins and count change. Add or subtract items in your house or while shopping at the store. Group and count objects in your house. Count to 100 by ones, fives, and tens. Practice reading page numbers. Identify and create patterns. Measure items in the kitchen or garden. Recite address and phone number. Name two and three dimensional shapes.

Religion

Science and Social Studies

Language Arts

We are practicing short vowel word families, blends, digraphs, and silent e. Please have your child read the fluency passages to you five or more times to build reading fluency.


