Social Studies

In history we will be looking at the growing pains of the new nation and at the issues that led to the Civil War. We will be learning about the Civil War and the major events and people that are part of this conflict. We will be learning about important documents in US history.

Math

Students will be completing a review and taking the summative assessment and the end-of-year math tests which will each part provide data used to determine 6th grade math placement.

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (khanacademy.org). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The **4th quarter** requirements to complete for Math: 5th grade are *Multiplying Fractions* (unit 6), *Algebraic Thinking* (unit 13), and *Dividing Decimals* (unit 9).

Completion due date is 5/28.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week students continued reading *The Phantom Tollbooth*, and we will finish that early next week. They will have a test on the novel on Wednesday, and the Dodecahedron project will also be due next Wednesday. Students also work on the revised drafts of the research paper, and they will be writing the final drafts next week.

Theology

This week, we finished our unit on the Beatitudes with a quiz on the final four Beatitudes, and students turned in the unit-long project.

Next week, we will wrap up our year in theology with an Escape Room that covers many of the topics we covered this year.
