Social Studies

We focused on science this week.

Math

We are reviewing addition, subtraction and three dimensional shapes. The students are continuing to practice the name and value of a penny, nickel, dime, quarter and half dollar. We also continued to practice counting to 100! Some of them already know how to count to 100. At this time, the students are expected to count to 100.

The students have also been counting to 100 by 2s, 5s and 10s. We have calendar time during math every day.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

The students are continuing to practice reading to self and work on writing. Please have your child read the books and reading comprehension packets sent home every Friday to you three times to practice sight words and fluency. **Our sight words this week were: first, does, write, always, made. Our sight words for next week are: gave, us, buy, those, use.**

Theology

We have been reading a chapter book called What Would Jesus Do? We will be participating in the rosary as a whole school every Thursday for the month of May.

Science

We spoke about the different types of habitats animals live in every day throughout the year. We also made flowers for the eighth graders.
