Math, Science and Social Studies

Social Studies

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. We will be learning about what our nation looks like at 50. As we continue through the 4th quarter we will be looking at the causes of the Civil War. Our last project in social studies will be a timeline that we will complete in class.

Math

We have been working on reviewing for the End of Year test (EYO) that will be on 5/29-5/31. There will be no math homework this week due to the intensive review and testing schedule.

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy ([khanacademy.org](https://www.khanacademy.org)). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 4rd qtr. requirements, **due before the end of the quarter 5/23/24** are Multiplying Fractions, Algebraic Thinking and Divide Decimals (under 5th grade - **not** Getting Ready for 5th).

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week students finished reading *The Phantom Tollbooth* and worked on the Dodecahedron Project in connection with this novel. The Project will be due Friday, May 31. The test on the novel will be Thursday, May 20. Students have also worked on the revised draft of the research paper, and we will be editing those in class next week to be turned in on Wednesday.

Theology

This week we started our unit on the Beatitudes. Students have been working on a small, in-class project in connection with this, and that will be turned in on Monday, June 3. There will not be a test or quiz on the material, but we will conclude the unit with an Escape Room activity based on the Beatitudes.

Science

We have been learning about weather. Our Ch. 11 Weather and Climate Test is on May 30th.
