Any medications left in the clinic will be disposed of by 6/10/2023. In preparing for next school year, an **UPDATED**

medication authorization form and medical condition action plan MUST be provided to the school nurse on or before the first day of school. Action Plans and Medication Authorization Forms are located in FACTS under resource documents. If your student is eligible for "self-carry", it must be indicated on the forms by a licensed medical provider. Remember, per Diocesan Policy, no medication, prescription or over the counter, can be dispensed to your student without authorization from a parent AND licensed medical provider.

Social Studies

Students say prayers and the Pledge of Allegiance each day. We focused on science this week.

Math

The students are practicing word problems with addition and subtraction. We are also reviewing left and right. We have also been enjoying centers which include work with a teacher, using math manipulatives to review certain skills, math binders and math games. The students are enjoying and practicing a lot of skills during math.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

We continued fluency passages. Each passage focuses on a particular word family, consonant blend, or digraph. Please have your child read these passages to you at home.

Theology

During Theology this week, we continued our chapter book What Would Jesus Do? We reviewed some of the sacraments and drew different items we see, hear, smell, taste and touch during mass in the church or in our school when we have mass on Tuesdays.

Science
