Social Studies

We have been focusing on the causes of the Civil War. In class this week we will be learning about some key figures of the Civil War.

Math

We will be reviewing math concepts this week and solving composite volume problems.

*Students will need to complete (mastery level) Khan Academy *Add and Subtract Fractions, Multiplying Fractions, and Algebraic Thinking* by the end of the 4th quarter.

* Please practice the basic multiplication facts at home or in the car coming to and from school. Knowing your multiplication facts is a vital skill that students will be needing for success in math in school and in daily life.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week students continued learning how to diagram sentences and worked on the Dodecahedron project. They also wrote the rough draft of their short story.

Next week, we will have a quiz on diagramming sentences (subject, verb, subject complements, prepositions, and modifiers) and will continue to write their short stories. They will also present their fourth quarter IRAs.
