Math

Ms. Shank has completed math assessments. You should have already received those in your child's red folders. The rest of the year we will be reviewing and playing math games.

Ms. Wawner's class worked on subtraction, including subtracting using a number line. We are beginning to review our mathematical skills we have learned over the past school year.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Ms. Wawner's class focused on the word family ending in -it this week. We have enjoyed playing write-the-room, reading emergent readers while identifying -it words as well. We are continuing to add new sight words to our wall each week. This week's sight word is: this and last week's sight word was my. We are also reviewing our letter sounds and letter formations as our school year comes to a close.

Ms. Shank's class started our Dr. Suess author study. We read lots of Suess books and had fun rhyming. We read "Oh the Places You Will Go" and they chose their own place they would like to travel to. We are also in the process of making a class book based on the story "Ten Apples Up On Top". They each chose two things that they would like to put on top of their Suess hat. I have already completed a letter and letter sound assessment. You should have received those in your child's red folder. I just completed an assessment on rhyming knowledge. I will be sending that home.

Religion

Ms. Shank's class will be completing the Fruits of the Spirit study. We will end the year the way we started the year and practiced throughout the year, by talking about how to be like Christ.

Ms. Wawner's class has been working on our Fruits of the Spirit study. The children have been working hard on their Fruits of the Spirit books.

Science

Ms. Wawner's class began and finished up our plant study unit. We enjoyed going on nature walks, reading lots of books on plants and watching our seeds grow in the classroom. We also were able to release our butterflies!

Ms. Shank's class finished our community helpers unit. The students created maps of their own town. They chose a community helper they wanted to be and we created hats. Next week we will be doing some fun science experiments.
