Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students finished *Number the Stars*. This is a historical fiction book. Students also continued work in their historical fiction book clubs. Throughout this novel, we have focused on how to take effective notes and how reading historical fiction books can really shape our perspectives!

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students continued chapter 9 which focuses on how Virginia has changed throughout the last century.

The Chapter 9 test is scheduled for Thursday (6/2).

Math

In Math this week we have been focused on lines of symmetry, different types of angles, and classifying Triangles and Quadrilaterals. We used our knowledge of lines to create angles, and are currently working to classify, draw, and measure angles with a protractor.

The Ch. 14 Math test is scheduled for Thursday, 6/2.

Science

In Science this week we have been focused on forces and motion.

Religion

In Religion we have enjoyed collaborating in different prayer circles daily to conduct our lessons. This week we have focused on topics to include the Beatitudes, Original Sin, our Parishes, the Bible, Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy, the 4 Cardinal Virtues and Vocations.

Students have officially completed their "Unstuck" Lesson series on emotional regulation with Mrs. Bryan. She highly recommends a celebratory treat for your student for completing this course, and continued conversation and support in this area with your children at home. They have learned many tools and strategies for overcoming tough situations that they would be happy to share with you.

Field Day 2022 JK-6th

Dear Parents,

Parents, we are so excited to be offering this again and can't wait to see all the students and volunteers. Please read ahead to get a quick note on what is required of your child on field day. All other notes regarding field day activities and movement patterns will be answered and addressed by their classroom teachers. All activities this day will involve lots of movement and lots of water. Given the duration of the day, it is extremely important to have a few items accompanied by each student. Please see the list below. I do though need to stress that students must have a labeled water bottle.

All essential items needed this day (with a few rules):

- Bathing suits are not required - If worn, they must be covered by shorts and a tee shirt at all times. Swim trunks are fine but shirt tops are to remain on.
- Sunscreen, Sunscreen, and Sunscreen
- Comfortable loose fitting athletic attire that meets dress code requirements •

A change of clothes, FULL set of clothes, and change of shoes, socks too!

- Hats are acceptable on this day as they provide sun blockage
- No sunglasses (Unless prescription)
- LABELED Water Bottle (super important we stay hydrated on this day.)
- Towel (1 should be ok, as heat should dry towels quickly)
