#### Science/Social Studies

Ms. Wawner's class conducted a honey bee inquiry this week. We brainstormed all the things we knew about bees, then we came up with questions that we wanted to find the answers to. We learned about the different jobs of worker bees, bee life cycles, how bees make honey, and why bees dance. We created bee costumes and simulated life in the hive, with everyone having their important role, like queen, cleaner, forager, builder, and guard. Next week we will start a unit on plants. Ms. Shank's class watched our caterpillars change into a chrysalis. We are hoping them hatch in the next week. We started a study of bees. Next week we will investigate flies and ants.

#### Math

Ms. Wawner's class started playing with subtraction this week. We learned how to read a subtraction math sentence and we played different games to help us understand that subtraction means taking away a number from another number to find the difference. We played "build and remove" with unifix cubes, and "build and smash" with play-do. We will

continue to work on subtraction next week. Ms. Shank's class will continue to work on subtraction and review concepts we have learned so far.

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Ms. Wawner's class finished our alphabet study last week with the letter X. This week we started a review of letters. We are working each day on our handwriting and letter formation. We are learning about CVC words and how we can decode them by breaking them down into sounds. We are focusing on -AT word families first. Ms. Shank's class has been reviewing the letters and sounds. Some reading groups are working on short vowel CVC word families. We will also begin a study of the author Eric Carle.

### **Theology**

Ms. Wawner's class talked about Mary this week. We started our Decade of the Rosary on Thursday mornings. Ms. Shank's class has begun a unit on Mother Mary.

Many doctor's offices get busy over the summer with form requests, please ask for this as soon as possible. Your child CAN NOT attend school until these papers are provided and are reviewed by the school nurse. Feel free to start sending them in from now.
