<u>Math</u>

Ms. Shank's class will continue to work on our addition and subtraction unit. Ms. Wawner's class continued to practice addition and introduced subtraction through the part/part/whole method. Students will continue to practice addition and subtraction next week.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Ms. Wawner's class focused on the letter X this week. Students had fun going on an X scavenger hunt, playing tic-tac-toe, and creating x-ray hands. We have now spent special time on each letter of the alphabet and will continue to review letter identification and phonics for the rest of the year. Next week students will start learning word families. They will start with -AT and focus on a new one each week until the end of the school year. We will also continue to practice and add to our sight words list.

Ms. Shank's class is reviewing concepts we have learned so far. We continue to have reading groups. Our sight word for next week is "with".

Religion

Ms. Shank's class started our study of Our Lady, Mary, the mother of the Church. We read about the major events in her life and how her amazing "Yes" led us to our salvation.

Science

Ms. Wawner's class started a Social Students unit on Community Helpers. We talked about what a community is and different types of communities (city, town, suburb, countryside). We then identified different community helpers and talked about their jobs. This week, we focused on those who keep us safe and those who work at schools. We learned about a firefighters day on the job and had the chance to role play. We will continue with our community helper unit next week.

Ms. Shank's class started our study of plants this week. We examined seeds and planted our own lima bean seed. We learned about the life cycle of the plant and the plant parts and their functions. We even dissected a celery stalk when we talked about the function of the stem. We will continue this next week.
