Language Arts-

In Language Arts this week, students continued *Number the Stars*. This is a historical fiction book. Students also began work in their historical fiction book clubs.

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students completed Chapter 8 which focuses on the post Civil War period. Students also began work on a project about the Industrial Revolution!

The Industrial Revolution Project is due Friday, May 12.

Math

In Math this week, we finished our Unit on Measurement. The students took their test on the Metric system, and we began Chapter 13 on Perimeter and Area. The students came up with Area and Perimeter formulas themselves! We have enjoyed playing "Conquer the Area" on graph paper and solving word problems related to Perimeter and Area to better understand this topic.

Science

In Science this week we have been focused on light and heat. We have been learning about ways light travels, and how heat is transferred, produced, and used.

Religion

In Religion this week we have been focused on the liturgical season of Easter. In this Unit we highlighted the importance of our Baptism and acknowledged the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation.
