Social Studies

In history we will be looking at the growing pains of the new nation and at the issues that led to the Civil War. We will be learning about the Civil War and the major events and people that are part of this conflict. We will be completing a big timeline project for the major events of the Civil War.

Math

Students will be working on fraction-decimal-percent relationships and starting our unit	on
measurement.	

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (khanacademy.org). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The **4th quarter** requirements to complete for Math: 5th grade are *Multiplying Fractions* (unit 6), *Algebraic Thinking* (unit 13), and *Dividing Decimals* (unit 9).

Completion due date is 5/28.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week students continued reading *The Phantom Tollbooth* and had a test on the first half of the novel. They also received a project connected to this novel (the Dodecahedron Project), which will be due when we finish reading the book. Students also turned in the rough drafts of their research papers, and received a new list of spelling/vocabulary words.

Next week, we will work on the revised drafts of the research paper, continue to read *The Phantom Tollbooth*, and have a test on the spelling/vocabulary words.

The fourth quarter IRA is due Friday, May 23.

Theology

This week, we continued our unit on the Beatitudes. Students had a quiz on the first four Beatitudes this week and continued to work on the unit-long project. We will focus on the last four Beatitudes next week and will have a quiz on those the following week.
