## Social Studies

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In class this week we will be learning about the Gettysburg Address.

## Math

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We have been reviewing math concepts and solving composite volume problems. We will be graphing data in different formats.

\*Students will need to complete (mastery level) Khan Academy *Add and Subtract Fractions*, *Multiplying Fractions*, and *Algebraic Thinking* by the end of the 4th quarter.

\* Please practice the basic multiplication facts at home or in the car coming to and from school. Knowing your multiplication facts is a vital skill that students will be needing for success in math in school and in daily life.

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

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This week students turned in the Dodecahedron project, which will be returned to them next week so students can construct the three-dimensional object. The graded rough of the short story was graded and returned to students, and they wrote the revised draft of the paper. The final draft will be due next Tuesday. Students also took a grammar quiz on diagramming sentences.

## Religion
