Also, please encourage your child to do some writing over the summer. It could range from writing personal narratives or other fictional stories, creative writing like poetry, expository/informational, or just writing in a daily journal/diary. Remind your child that the Somebody, Wanted, But, So, Then model for summarizing, as well as our hamburger structure (topic sentence, 3 supporting details, and conclusion sentence), can be effective ways to help organize and generate ideas for their writing. Additionally, practicing cursive writing or typing skills (typing.com) could be a few other things that your child spends time on.
