Social Studies

This Week: Students are working on their autobiography and participating in a scavenger hunt to get to know their classmates.

Next Week: Students will learn about parts of a map and identify the seven continents on a map.

Math

This Week: Students are learning about our money system for third grade. They have set up their math journals and agenda to record their total amount of currency and coins earned on Friday.

Next Week: Students will learn about place value up to the hundreds. They will explain and demonstrate strategies using place value blocks. They will be introduced to writing the three digit numbers in three forms- standard method, expanded method and word form.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This Week:

Students completed two initial benchmark assessments (A Spelling Inventory and Oral Reading Fluency) and a baseline writing assessment that will help guide instruction moving forward. We also shared our summer reading assignments and worked through our "First Day Jitters" with several activities that helped break the ice and get to know one another a little better. Finally, we introduced a weekly Grammar activity using a mentor sentence to highlight specific skills and review broader writing and grammar rules. This type of activity will be completed often throughout the year.

Next Week:

-Word Study (Spelling): Short Vowel Blends (tent, flag, sled, milk) - Quiz - Friday

-Writing/Grammar - Mentor Sentence Quiz - Friday

- -Skill(s): Adjectives, Subject/Predicate
- -Mentor Text: Enemy Pie
- -Mentor Sentence: Dad dished up three plates, side by side, with big pieces of pie and giant scoops of ice cream.
- -Reading Story Elements/Summarizing

Theology

This Week:

We introduced and practiced school-wide prayers, met with our 7th grade Faith Buddies, and prepared for our first school Mass of the year. This included looking at upcoming readings and reinforcing appropriate mass behaviors/expectations.

Science

This Week: Students will be introduced to the steps in the scientific method and inquiry tools we will be using with our experiments.
