Grades K - 3 on Mondays from 3:30 - 4:35

This energetic and exciting class is designed to provide young dancers with an introduction to the fundamentals of tap dance. Early exposure to the rhythms and unique mind-to-foot connection associated with tap dance will allow students to progress and excel at the art as they

We will build our knowledge of ceramics with a focus on hand-building techniques, surface decoration, and an introduction to the potter's wheel.

Students should bring clothes to change into that can get dirty.

Social Studies

We talked about citizenship and the importance of the pledge of allegiance. Also, we spoke about working together as a classroom and being a community. Our classrooms are similar to a family where we respect and are kind to each other.

Math

We practiced counting to 100! Some of them already know how to count to 100. But, at this time, the students are only expected to count to twenty five. We also started calendar time during math. The students learned our days of the week song as well as our months of the year song. Our students also talked about the four seasons God created.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

We have been introduced to books with just pictures as well as books with simple words. The students have also been able to choose books for their book bins. They are so excited to start reading!

Theology

The students learned that theology is the study of religion, and that we are learning about the Catholic religion in our school. The students also were taught that many Christian prayers are similar to the prayers we say in Catholicism.

Science

We talked about that when the construction downstairs is finished, we will go to the STEM lab a few times every week. This week we reviewed the rules and procedures. It is going to be a great year in science!
