Week in Review

Religion

We have been talking about the Story of Creation and have been practicing the pledge to the flag and our prayers (The blessing, Our Father, Hail Mary, and glory Be.) We went on a nature walk and then made prayer rocks to remind us to pray.

Science

In the Science Lab we invited Nurse Q. in to talk to us about good hygiene. We learned that we should cough or sneeze into our elbows and use hand sanitizer or wash our hands after using the restroom and before we eat. We did a science experiment with soap, water, and pepper in which we made the "germs" disappear.

Math
