We will begin our one on one assessment of each child next week, so that we have a beginning point for everyone. **Next Week** Students will be doing lots of fun activities centered around the book Chicka Chicka Boom Boom. We will continue learning about Creation and exploring Math manipulatives and numbers 1-5.

Week in Review

Religion

We have been talking about the Story of Creation and have been saying our prayers. We colored things that God created and listened to a song about the days of creation..

Science

We discussed staying safe by: washing our hands, wearing face coverings, and coughing or sneezing into our elbows. Nurse Weber showed the class how to properly wash their hands. On Wednesday, we made an egg float by adding salt to the water and increasing the density of the water. On Thursday, we put vinegar and food coloring in a cup with a raw egg. Students saw bubbles in the cup. On Monday, we will check our eggs to see what the acid in the vinegar did to the eggs.

Math

We have been adding a date to the calendar, counting the number of days in school, finding the calendar's pattern for the month, saying the days of the week and months of the year, talking about the temperature, and discussing seasons.

Language Arts

We have been reading lots of books. We often look for rhyming words, how the characters are treating each other, and how they solve problems. We have discussed three ways to read a book: read the pictures, read the words, and retell the story.
