It was another fabulous week in first grade. The students performed well on their MAP testing, we had our first official fire drill of the year, and our first Mass together as a school. Social Studies

This week we introduced our journal as well as more routines and procedures.

Math

This week we talked about how math is not just counting, but is all around us - in baking, music, traveling, etc. We discovered that we all have math superpowers that will help us as we explore mathematical concepts in the coming year.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we continued to discuss/practice procedures and routines during language arts/reading time. We reviewed letters (consonants and vowels), parts of a book, author and illustrator, and setting. Students began writing sentences in their writing journals in response to our reading, as well as practicing handwriting skills (e.g., letter formation and names), spelling, and word work skills. Next week, we will focus on setting and introducing nouns.

Theology

In Theology this week, we talked about the importance of self-control as we prepared for Mass. We learned that the Bible is God's holy word and that there are two parts to the Bible, as well as four gospels. We read Jesus' parable of the wise man who built his house upon the rock and related it to the importance of knowing God's Word.

Science

This week we made our interactive science journal where we will record everything we will learn this year.
