Social Studies

We continued to talk about citizenship and the importance of the pledge of allegiance. Also, we spoke about working together as a classroom and being a community. Our classrooms are similar to a family where we respect and are kind to each other. We are reviewing our classroom rules every day.

Math

We continued to count to 100! Some of them already know how to count to 100. But, at this time, the students are only expected to count to twenty five. We also created number hats from 0 to 10. The students have been enjoying our days of the week song as well as our months of the year song. Our students also talked about the four seasons God created. We will be gluing our September calendar in our math books Monday. The students have also been coloring our 180 day ten frame chart and color a number in our hundreds chart.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Our class has been continuing to learn about the three ways to read a book: read the words, look at the pictures or retell the story. The students have also been able to choose books for their book bins. Students did several fun activities centered around the books Chicka Chicka Boom Boom and Chicka Chicka 123. Activities related to letter recognition, matching and number recognition.

We read the first book in the alphabet series Little ___ Had a Box. After reading each book, students will practice writing the corresponding letter and draw pictures in their alphabet journal that begin with that specific letter such as fire, fence, five, fork for Little F Had a Box.

Theology

We have been talking about the Story of Creation and have been saying our prayers. We colored things that God created and listened to a song about the days of creation.

We talked about how God made each of us special. We started our My All About Me book. We also made special prayer rocks and said our poem that went along with it.

Science

We went to the STEM lab twice this week to review the rules and procedures again. We also made erupting apple volcanoes so the students could observe and draw what they noticed. They really liked that experiment!
