Social Studies

This week in SS, students completed their first research project! This was a really fun, engaging activity in which students were able to choose among 5 influential Americans from the past to research and present on.

Next week, we will begin our first unit which focuses on the 5 regions of Virginia. Students will learn what makes each region unique.

Math

This week in Math, we had our first test and began our next unit of addition and subtraction strategies. Questions from the test that students struggled with will be used as part of our reviews in class to clarify students' understanding.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in LA, students began our newest novel, *The Tiger Rising*. This is a wonderful story that students are thoroughly enjoying.

Next week, we will continue to read this novel.

Theology

This week in Theology, we worked through our chapter looking at who God is. We discussed the Blessed Trinity and learned about St. Elizabeth Catez. Students also learned about Pentecost and imagined what it would have felt like to be present there.

Science

This week on Science, we had a quiz on cells, types of plants, and categories of animals. We also checked on our mold to see if it had grown. We have begun to look at the parts of plants and how they reproduce. Next week we will be doing a plant dissection for students to get a hands-on look at the inner workings of flowering plants.
