Teacher's Message/Announcements

Please continue to practice the sight words every day.

*Please remember to have your child's library books in their backpacks on Monday mornings so they can check new ones out.

Next month, we will learn about community helpers. Traditionally, we have had parents come in and talk about their occupations. Homework: Kindergarten homework for first semester is to listen to a parent read a story each day and apply reading comprehension skills: such as answer questions, identify the characters and setting, make predictions, and retell the story. Students will also practice reading books as they are sent home. Please have your child point to each word and read the book three or more times. Keep the book in a bag by the bed so that your child can continue to practice and build reading fluency. Sight words will be coming home today. Please practice these at home until your child can say them automatically.

Students are learning to be more independent. Please continue to encourage self help skills at home when possible such as: tucking in shirts, fastening belts, opening containers and packages, folding towels, cleaning up, straightening and putting things away.

Social Studies

We spoke about different types of families including the holy family, nuclear families, extended and blended families as well as multicultural families. The

students were able to identify members in their own families and what responsibilities they have in their families. We spoke about how families need love, God, food, water, etc. The students understood that there are rules, decisions and communication skills in every family. They also learned that we are unique people created in God's image. We learned to have positive attitudes toward others and to treat family members with respect.

Math

We started Unit 2 in math which includes numbers up to five. We also continued to practice counting to 100! Some of them already know how to count to 100. But, at this time, the students are only expected to count to twenty five. We have calendar time during math every day. The students learn our days of the week song, months of the year song and seasons every day. The students are starting to understand how our math centers operate each day.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

The students are continuing to practice reading to self. They read books in the three ways we taught them: read the words, read the pictures and retell the story. We also started our first five sight words this week: for, in, said, you and it. Students practiced writing their sight words.

Please use the sight word resources in your child's folder to help your child practice sight words at home.

Theology

Our kindergarteners are learning how Mary is our mother and Jesus' mother too. They learned who Jesus' grandparents were when he lived on Earth. We talked about the church and who is in the Holy Family. Each student is continuing to learn what God made during the creation stories. They are also learning that God loves them and created pictures of what God created. We are talking about who saints are and what they do. The children are doing a wonderful job with their answers for these questions: Who is God and who is Jesus? How can we be followers of God? We also go to the chapel once a week to learn bible stories and sing songs. We read a Bible story each day, prayed and talked about how Joseph forgave his brothers. We also have a science related devotion each day and we are learning a lot about God's amazing world.
