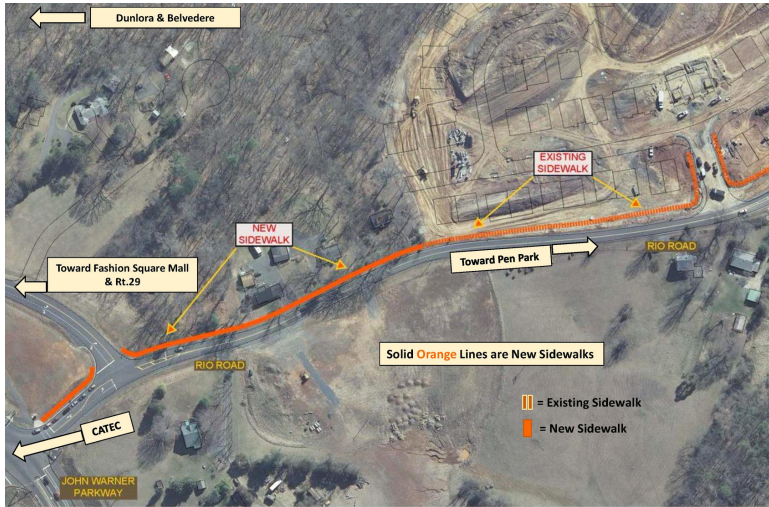


# UPCOMING SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION PROJECT & TRAFFIC IMPACTS

We are excited to announce the start of important pedestrian safety & sidewalk improvements on Rio Road. Traffic will be impacted during construction. Please see below for details.



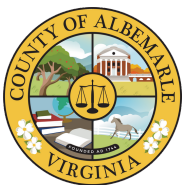
## Construction activity anticipated between 9/20-12/17 Lane closures anticipated between 10/4-11/23

- All lane closures will occur between 9 am - 4 pm (*entrances/exits to schools should not be impacted during busy hours of the day*)
- No lane closures will occur during peak hours, overnight, holidays, or weekends
- Dates are subject to change depending on weather and unforeseen field conditions
- Expect flagging operations & rumble strips

This project is what is referred to as a Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) Revenue Sharing project. Revenue Sharing projects are projects where partial funding is provided by VDOT to help localities improve transportation and connectivity in their respective communities. County planners and engineers prepare project submissions for VDOT funding. In this case, our project was selected over dozens of other projects from around the Commonwealth.

Revenue Sharing projects are a great way to provide responsible stewardship for County taxpayers by maximizing our investments in this important infrastructure. In this case, VDOT is providing 50% of the funding to execute this project, and that means the County is getting twice the project for our funding investment on this project.
