Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students learned not only how to summarize, but to synthesize stories, envision settings, and make inferences. We are about halfway through our first novel!

Students will also continue their nightly reading logs next week. This will be in their homework folder. Students are expected to read and fill out their reading log nightly Monday through Friday.

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students worked on and finished our "Great American Hero" research project. In this project, students were able to choose 1 of 5 possible American heroes and create a Google Slides presentation on them

Math

In Math this week, we took our test on Chapter 1, and began Chapter 2. We learned all about the Identity, Commutative and Associative Properties of Addition, Rules of Subtraction with 0's, addition and subtraction within 10's, 100's, 1,000's. 10,000's etc., and how to add and subtract mentally by making a ten, hundred or thousand in a given equation.

Science

In Science this week we have been focused on Chapter 1. We learned about the 5 Kingdoms scientists use to classify organisms, and are making illustrative diagrams of plant/animal cells to help us learn the functions of each organelle. We also learned about vascular vs. nonvascular plants, and about vertebrates and invertebrates.

Religion

Students have enjoyed being reflective about their special mission as anointed disciples of Christ. We have highlighted God's distinct plan for us and how we were created uniquely in his image and likeness. Other themes we have been focused on this week include dignity, faith, and love.
