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### **Social Studies**

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. We will have a test on the states and capitals for the SE region of the US. on 9/26. . This week we will be learning about the Jamestown and Plymouth settlements.

Students in 5th grade will be tested on all US states and their capitals. The states will be chunked by region for learning and mastery. A great way to study the states is found on a free game learning website:

### Math

This week we used place value to round numbers. We are going to focus on adding and subtracting decimals. The key to success is rewriting the problems vertically so that the decimals align. We will also be reviewing estimating using decimals.

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (khanacademy.org). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 1st qtr. requirements, due before the end of the quarter are Decimal Place Value, Add Decimals and Subtract Decimals.

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we began reading Wonder and focused on run-on sentences and how to correct them. Students also began a short unit in word-study work. In this type of spelling work, students focus on spelling patterns, using simpler words, so that they can then apply those patterns to the spelling of more complex words. They will have a test on those words and patterns next Wednesday.

We will continue reading and annotating *Wonder* next week. Most days, after a homework assignment in which students must read a part of the novel, they will have a brief quiz on the material to be sure they are reading and understanding the text they read. They will also have a quiz on identifying and correcting run-on sentences.

# Theology

This week we focused on a short unit in the Theology textbook about ways we come to know God. Next week we will begin a unit on the Rosary. Also, 5B (Samley) homeroom will be coording Mass for Friday, September 29.

### Science

We will be comparing plant and animal cells. We will be learning about organizing living things.
