## **English Language Arts**

This week we wrapped up our unit on nouns. A study guide should be coming home for the test on 9/28 (Tuesday). We also continued on with our novel study and handwriting.

Next week we will be continuing on with our novel study, cursive, and prompt writing. We will be testing on our noun unit and starting our next grammar unit. Spelling words will remain the same for next week.

### Religion

This week the students work on the four marks of the church project to better under what we believe.

Next week, we will be reviewing for the test on 9/29 (Wednesday). We also will start a brief unit on the rosary.

#### Math

This week we are continuing to learn about place value through the ten thousands place and will continue with comparing and ordering these numbers using the greater than, less than, and equal to symbols. We are also practicing our basic addition fluency.

Next week we will review rounding numbers to the nearest ten and learn how to round numbers to the nearest hundreds and thousands.

Homework: The math homework will be in their blue homework folder, and please look over their agenda for their math assignments on Monday and Wednesday afternoon.

#### Science

This week we will learn about the building blocks of plant and animal cells, the scientific method, and vocabulary for living organisms. Our project will include observing the stages of the plant life cycle, and learning about metamorphosis.

Next week we'll be learning about parts of living things and how living things grow and change in their environment. Our vocabulary will include the stages in a life cycle and the process of metamorphosis by studying the life cycle of a ladybug..

### **Social Studies**

This week students will learn about the Mississippi River, Rio Grande River, Rocky Mountains, and the Appalachian Mountains. We are also learning for our Spanish Heritage month about Honduras's rainforest animals and designing our rainforest door themes.

Next week we will learn about the Five Great Lakes, and their location in the United States. We will be completing our Honduras rainforest themed doors with their flag.
