Next Week

- In Language Arts, we will continue our first novel, "The Tiger Rising". Students will also continue to learn about how characters can change during stories, the intricacies of the author's craft, and how to find significant evidence to support their claims.
- In Social Studies, we will officially start Ch. 1 of our Virginia History textbook. Our first section is an overview on the geographic regions of Virginia.
- In Math, we will continue Chapter 2: "Adding and Subtracting Whole Numbers." This test is scheduled for Tuesday, October 5th.
- In Science we will begin Chapter 2: "Life Cycles."
- In Religion we will continue Unit 1 Lesson 4: "Who is Jesus Christ?" This quiz is scheduled for <u>Thursday, 9/30.</u> We will then begin Unit 1 Lesson 5: "Who is the Church".

Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students learned how to look deeper into what characters say and do during stories. Students learned that oftentimes, the author has deeper meaning than what's on the page and to figure it out we need to ask ourselves questions as readers.

Students will also continue their nightly reading logs next week. This will be in their homework folder. Students are expected to read and fill out their reading log nightly Monday through Friday.

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students worked on and presented the "Great American Hero" research project. We also read and studied about Hispanic Heritage Month.

Math

In Math this week we learned how to round to estimate sums and differences, how to add through the hundred thousands place with regrouping (checking our answers using estimation), and how to subtract whole numbers through the hundred thousands place and across multiple zeros.

Science

In Science this week we continued to work on our Plant and Animal Cell. We also learned more about various types of Vascular and Non-vascular Plants, and Vertebrates and Invertebrates. Additionally, we have been working this week to shape our independent study skills.

Religion

In Religion, we finished Lesson 3. We discussed the roles of faith and grace, and of our constant invitation to live in communion with God to be able to live with him in eternal life. We studied a family of saints as inspirational partners in faith. This encouraged us to reflect on the importance of our family, and to strive to act as saints in our everyday lives. We began Chapter 4, focusing on the Immaculate Conception of Mary, and reflected on the remarkable examples both Jesus and Mary set for us to follow. We are in charge of Mass roles on Friday, October 1st.

This week we had the opportunity to decorate our classroom door with Our Lady of Guadalupe. 4th grade was assigned to learn about the country of "Mexico" in celebration of Hispanic Heritage Month. 4B chose to portray Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico's honor.
