Tap Dance - Mrs. Mitchell (<u>c.mitchell@cvillecatholic.org</u>) Grades K - 3 on Mondays from 3:30 - 4:35 Dates: September 30 October 14, 21, 28 November 4, 11, 18 December 2, 9, 16 This energetic and exciting class is designed to provide young dancers with an introduction to the fundamentals of tap dance. Early exposure to the rhythms and unique mind-to-foot connection associated with tap dance will allow students to progress and excel at the art as they move through life. Students will need tap shoes for the class.

### Social Studies

This week we talked about Mother Teresa. We read about her life, sequenced the events in her life and created a magazine cover to keep in our interactive notebook. Next week we will talk about Hispanic Heritage month.

### Math

This week we continued our study on number sense. We learned about rows vs columns in a 120s chart, how to find one more and one less of a certain number, and how to find a missing number on a 120s chart. Next week we will wrap up our study of number sense and we will introduce place value.

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

#### <u>Reading</u>

This week we read and discussed the story, *Make Way for Ducklings*. Our focus was on Describing a Character, which included identifying outward characteristics as well as inner personality traits. A character's actions often tell us who they are and reveal their motivation, like the mother duck who is very proud of her ducklings. Next week we will read *Real Cowboys* and focus on asking and answering questions about what we read.

#### <u>Grammar</u>

This week we focused on Sentence Structure, reviewed Nouns, and introduced Verbs. Next week we will focus on asking sentences and how they end with question marks (?).

#### <u>Writing</u>

This week we wrote about Make Way for Ducklings, a story about two ducks searching for the

perfect spot to raise their ducklings. Our focus was on describing characters from the story. We also introduced/practiced Daily 5 writing activities.

# Theology

This week was all about preparation! We prepared for the feast of the archangels (our school mascot!) on September 29 by learning more about these honored saints and their role in many important accounts in the Bible. We, also, prepared for October as the month dedicated to the Holy Rosary by making our own rosaries that we'll be using on Thursday mornings throughout the month as we join our school in praying the luminous mysteries, which reflect on the life and ministry of Jesus.
