### Math

We have been continuing to focus on number sense skills. We have been learning about place value with three digit numbers, even and odd, skip counting by 5's and 10's and developing basic addition and subtraction fluency. Next week, we will learn how to solve repeated addition story problems.

### Language Arts/Reading/Writing

We read <u>A Visitor for Bear</u> by Bonny Becker, a story about an unlikely friendship that occurs from comedic persistence. We focused on drawing conclusions and making inferences by discussing the text, using our background knowledge then reading between the lines. We reviewed nouns, verbs, and adjectives. Students wrote about brown bears after reading a nonfiction reader about brown bears. Next week, we will read <u>I Need My Monster</u> by Amanda Noll. We will focus on making connections, common and proper nouns.

## Theology

This week in theology we focused on Who is God? We discussed the blessed trinity and students were able to make connections about what role the trinity plays in their own life and who Jesus is. Next week, each student will have their saint decided on and begin working on the saints project.

### Social Studies

This week we enjoyed celebrating Johnny Appleseed Day by learning who John Chapman was and how he came to be known by Johnny Appleseed.

### Science

This month is Hispanic Heritage month. This week in science, In science this week we learned about SonyaSotomayor. During our STEM Lab time we created the tallest tower of knowledge using only index cards and books.

Next week in STEM, we will be working on a project that will require cardboard cereal boxes, so if you have any please send them in on Monday. Thank you!
