Social Studies

We spoke about how to have respect for all people and what it means to be honest and truthful to oneself, others, parents and teachers. We drew pictures to show how to respect someone and be a good friend. We talked about how to be a nice person, how to control our bodies, showing effort every day, taking responsibility and participating in class.

Math

We finished the Unit 2 test and started Unit 3 which includes numbers up to 10. We also continued to practice counting to 100! Some of them already know how to count to 100. But, at this time, the students are only expected to count to twenty five. We have calendar time during math every day. The students continue to learn our days of the week song, months of the year song and seasons every day. The students are starting to understand how our math centers operate each day.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

The students are continuing to practice reading to self and work on writing. They read books in the three ways we taught them: read the words, read the pictures and retell the story. **Our sight words this week are: little, down, can, see, not.**

Theology

The students are learning about how God always loves and wants us to make good choices. God forgives us for our sins. We also learned about St. Mary of Egypt and how we need to treat others the way we want to be treated. We also watched a theology movie about the rosary. In October, every Thursday, we will be praying one decade of the rosary as a whole school outside on the basketball court. Eighth grade will lead us in the rosary.
