Social Studies

This week students are learning about our North American Continent. They are learning the location of the Mississippi and Rio Grande Rivers. Students are making a passport and will include the geographic features of our North American continent.

Next week students are continuing to learn facts on the Mississippi and Rio Grande Rivers and how they have influenced our world. They will also be introduced to The Five Great Lakes region and identify the lakes on their map.

Math

This week students are learning to write numbers in standard, expanded and word form to the hundred thousands place. They will also be working on adding and subtracting using the regrouping process to keep a running balance in their checking and savings accounts.

Next week students will continue with using the three different forms of writing numbers up to the hundred thousands place. They will be introduced to comparing numbers and ordering numbers using the greater than, less than, and equal to signs, up to the hundred thousands place.

We enjoyed reading and discussing our read aloud story, *Finding Winnie*, the real-life inspiration and origin story, so to speak, of Winnie the Pooh (Focusing on asking questions while reading), focused on Commas in a Series, Nouns, and even more Subject and Predicate, and continued to develop our writing skills by incorporating various parts of speech and structure into our sentences.

Theology

This Week:

This week we learned who God is, how we can know him through creation, and that he reveals himself as One God in Three Divine Persons (Blessed Trinity - God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit). We also had fun meeting with our 7th grade faith buddies, who helped us complete activities about the Archangels and with learning the St. Michael prayer.

Next Week:

Students will finish Lesson 2 (Unit 1) and our discussion on who is God. We will also be praying the rosary as a community for the first time next week. On Thursday mornings in October, we will pray a decade of the Rosary together. We will be praying the Luminous Mysteries, reflecting on the life and ministry of Jesus. For those who do not know, the Rosary is a traditional Catholic devotion consisting of praying common prayers (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, etc.) while meditating on the mysteries of the life of Christ. Science

This week students are learning about the earth's axis, rotation, and revolution around the sun and how it affects our seasons. We will also practice the six steps in the scientific method

by learning the words in a song. They have started on their vocabulary flip books which will become their study guides.

Next week students will learn how the earth and moon interact in our solar system. They will begin by learning the different phases of the moon, and the difference between a solar and lunar eclipse.
