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## Social Studies

This week in SS, students began to learn about the wonderful state that they live in! We are going to be learning about the 5 regions of Virginia and what each has to offer. This unit will culminate with a very engaging and unique in class project!

Next week, we will continue to learn about the 5 regions of Virginia.

## Math

In Math this week, we began Unit 4. We have been focusing on comparing quantities with additive and multiplicative comparisons. The kids are better understanding the foundation of multiplication as "groups of", and are continuing to work on word problem language and interpret math sentences to determine operations in the process.

Our test over Unit 4 is scheduled for Thursday, October 5th.

# Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in LA, students continued *The Tiger Rising*. We continued some of the real learning that makes 4th grade such a great learning experience. Students are learning how characters in realistic fiction stories, just like real people, are complex! Students also practiced being more precise with their language when describing characters. We will be continuing to learn to base our ideas in evidence that the text provides.

We will have a spelling test over List 3 next Friday, October 6. Students have a list of these words in their homework folders.

## Theology

This week in Theology we finished Unit 1 Lesson 3: "Why did God make us?" We focused on the ways in which we can choose to say yes to God, and the things that go against trust in him. We focused on the gift of grace we've been given to share in God's life and love, and

began unit 1 Lesson 4 "Who is Jesus Christ?" 4T worked hard this week to plan Mass for Tuesday, 10/3.

# Science

In Science this week we continued Chapter 1. We have been focused on plant classifications, and vertebrates and invertebrates. We enjoyed our lab exploration with clay to observe differences between animals with backbones, or a "central support structure" (straw), and animals without. There will be a Chapter 1 Science Test on Friday, October 6.
