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Social Studies

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. We will have a test on the states and capitals for the N. Central region of the US. on 10/10. This week we will be learning about the Jamestown and Plymouth settlements.

Students in 5th grade will be tested on all US states and their capitals. The states will be chunked by region for learning and mastery. A great way to study the states is found on a free game learning website:

Math

This week we wrapped up our focus on decimals. We will begin working with exponents, equal groups, and multiplication with multiple digits.

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (<u>khanacademy.org</u>). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 1st qtr. requirements, due before the end of the quarter are Decimal Place Value, Add Decimals and Subtract Decimals.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we continued reading *Wonder* and had a quiz on run-on sentences. Students also had a test on their word-study words.

We will continue reading and annotating *Wonder* next week, and students will work on a precept project in class. They will also have a test on sentence fragments and run-on sentences, and one on the new vocabulary/spelling words they received.

Theology

This week we focused on the Rosary, including teaching our first grade Faith Buddies how to say the Rosary. Next week, they will have a test on the Rosary.

Science

This week we compared animal and plant cells. We will be learning about classification of living things.
