### Science

**This week** we will be identifying characteristics of living and nonliving things in an ecosystem, plant and animal cell structure, and learning the steps of the scientific method.

**Next week** students will learn about animal habitats and how living things grow and change in their environment. Students will be introduced to five new vocabulary words associated with the lifecycle of a butterfly. We will also continue to learn the steps of the scientific method.

### **Social Studies**

**This week** students will be finishing the geographic features of North America which includes the Rio Grande River, Mississippi River, the five Great Lakes, the Rockies and Appalachian Mountain ranges in North America.

**Next week** students will learn about South America and its geographic features. We are also decorating our door with the geographic features of Chile in celebration of Hispanic Heritage Month!

### Math

**This week** we learned the place value forms of writing numbers- standard, expanded and word form up to the hundred thousands place, as well as, identify ways to represent the same amount of money using different combinations of coins and bills.

**Next week** we will learn how to round numbers up to the tens, hundreds, and thousands place. Students will continue to work on counting currency and coins.

### Language Arts/Writing

#### This Week:

Our focus was on Common and Proper Nouns, as well as Vowel-Consonant-e Syllables (Also known as the "Magic e" - th**eme**, div**ide**, and cupc**ake** ), Affixes: ly, ing, e/es, ed, un, and re. We continued writing summaries by using the Somebody Wanted But So Then strategy, as well as introduced procedural writing. Students wrote recipes/directions for how to make something.

## Reading

#### This Week:

We finished our discussion of the book, *Saturdays and Teacakes* and reviewed vocabulary. We also practiced visualizing/creating mental images using our senses as we read through the book.

Students will have books assigned to them on their "Book Shelf" throughout the year. Our first book, *Mysteries according to Humphrey*, was assigned this week. This book will be read/listened to during class time, but it could also be included at home during the recommended 20 min./night. They can also download additional books to read as well.

## Religion

#### This Week:

We began Lesson 2 in our Religion textbook (Asking the questions, Who Is God and How do we see his love? We discussed the Blessed Trinity as well. Additionally, we continued learning about the structure of the mass. There are four parts of Mass: Introductory Rites, the Liturgy of the Word, the Liturgy of the Eucharist, and the Concluding Rite. We also introduced the Rosary and its purpose, prayers of the Rosary, and the scripture (Mysteries) that are connected with it.

#### **Next Week:**

We will continue working in our Religion textbook (Lesson 2). We will also be diving deeper into the Rosary (a Catholic devotion consisting of praying common prayers) in preparation for the month of October where we will be praying as a whole school on Tuesday mornings. Next week we will be praying 1 decade of the Sorrowful Mysteries, reflecting on the suffering and death of Jesus.
