- 3-5: introduction to equipment and instant activities (jump ropes, hula hoops, volleyball, basketball, soccer, and football), continuing learning appropriate tag games, relay races, working on reflexes and workout movements (push ups, high knees, jumping jacks, etc.)
- 6-8: Instant activities (jump ropes, hula hoops, volleyball, basketball, soccer, and football), conditioning with tag games, relay races with emphasis on sportsmanship, and lastly, preparation for fitness tests

<u>Middle School:</u> -Started with a combined art and music class for two weeks—created artwork using artistic interpretation of the music instruments within a piece of music using Kadinsky's artwork as an example and then musical interpretation of Kadinsky's artwork using musical terminology and form using C and G scales

- Started music classes for 6th, 7th and 8th grade— all classes start with drum circles and then 6th grade becomes choir/orff ensemble; 7th grade becomes digital music/piano and melodica unit; and 8th grade becomes orff instrument ensemble for the semester.

Elementary: 4th-5th grade: At the beginning of the school year, students received instructions about classroom procedures and rules. I provided them with information about the teams that we will develop and review during the first quarter. This first quarter they are reviewing the topic of cognates, greetings and farewells, the alphabet, numbers, the calendar, and the weather. They also have fun doing activities related to "Los cognados" playing Bingo related to vocabulary of the topics on review.

September marks the beginning of classroom SEL ("Social-Emotional Learning") lessons for JK-5th grade. Each grade level has two scheduled blocks per month, where they will receive explicit instruction and practice in a specific SE skill. This may involve topics like conflict resolution, emotional awareness/identification, emotional regulation strategies, positive communication, active listening, growth mindset, and more! This month, students are receiving introductory lessons about SEL and why it is important. An introductory presentation for middle school is also in the works. My role in the school involves planning and implementing SE classroom learning opportunities, but also allows me to provide extra support to students who may benefit from target skill development in a variety of SE topics, such as emotional regulation, social skills, etc. If you ever have concerns about your child's SE development, please feel free to contact me at the email listed above.
