Math

Curious cuties! The Hawks are learning to hone their super powers of wonder and observation to ignite their learning, as well as how to harness a positive mathematical mindset. From working together, to strategizing what to do when they get "stuck," mindset is powerful! A strong and positive self-view is fundamental to learning, and a beautiful way to begin the year as we collaborate, communicate, and critically think *together*.

With data from the MAP Math test and a beginning of year diagnostic test, the Hawks will begin small group instruction tailored to their mathematical pace next week.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

We "heart" reading! From read alouds to sustained silent reading, the Hawks wear their hearts on their wings! I adore watching these cute kiddos select books, light up as they buddy read a "fan favorite" from our class library, or giggle like crazy while listening to "The

Twits" by Roald Dahl, which is our latest read aloud, and is "laugh-out-loud-funny!" This hysterical book is perfect for introducing so many key components of reading: expression, intonation, comprehension, making inferences and predictions, delving into character development, analyzing elements of a story, and so much more!

Theology

Faith and friends make the world go 'round! Our sixth grade Faith Buddies joined us for Mass, serving as mentors and role models to the Hawks throughout the service. The Hawks will sit with their Faith Buddies at each Mass this school year, and will partner up with them for service opportunities, friendship activities, and faith-based projects.
