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Social Studies

This week in SS, students finished and presented their map projects. These were incredibly creative and a great way to start learning about maps.

Next week, students will learn about the difference between primary and secondary resources. This knowledge will help students throughout the year and jumpstarts our mini unit on how to research properly. We will also participate in the "Great American Hero" research project. This is a great opportunity for students to see what goes into a research project.

Math

This week in Math we enjoyed solidifying our understanding of Place Value. We took our Unit 1 test on Google Forms. We also began Unit 3: "Addition and Subtraction Strategies and Algorithms." We focused on estimating sums and differences involving multi-digit numbers, and used the estimate to determine whether or not the actual answer seemed reasonable. The kids loved playing "Estimate the Sum or Difference Bump" to reinforce the topic.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in LA, students learned how to "read intensely". We are working on how to become thoroughly engaged while reading. We also began *The Tiger Rising*. We will continue this work next week.

Theology

This week in Theology the kids took a quiz on Unit 1 Lesson 1: "How do we know God?" The quiz was taken on Google Forms. We also had a lesson on our September "Tenant of the Month": Respectfulness. We explored the Christian virtue of respect, and our Saint of the Month, St. Joseph; husband of Mary, and earthly Father of Jesus. We also began Unit 1 Lesson 2: "Who is God?" Today in Chapel we wrote God a letter to seek clarity in his plan for our lives. There will be a Unit 1 Lesson 2 Theology quiz on Friday, 9/15.

Science

This week in Science we dissected various Science skills such as observing, inferring, classifying, and comparing and applied them to our own lives. We realized just how often we utilize these skills! We also enjoyed our lab time on Thursday, during which we tested our straw models with weights, created hypotheses, and modified our design based on our experimentation. We have enjoyed putting the scientific method into practice! There will be a "Getting Ready for Science" Chapter Test on Friday, 9/15. A study guide of test topics will be provided.
