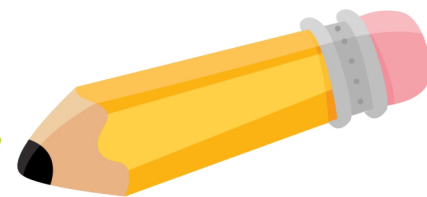
Religion
